

We thank Ridgewood Church for supporting our ministry and, through it, the work of the Association of Christian Camps and Conference Centers (ACCCC), which develops and supports Christian camping ministries in two Eastern European countries, Ukraine and Moldova, and in three Asian countries, Georgia, Armenia, and Country X. Please ask us personally about Country X.

Vladimir began his ministry in 1991, and Vira joined him after their marriage in 1996. Vladimir has served as CEO of ACCCC for the past 21 years. His work includes pastoral care, leadership training, financial oversight in five countries, and ministry fundraising and friend-raising. Vira assists Vladimir in his CEO role and also serves with Kingdom Ventures Inc. in Winnipeg as Administrative Coordinator.

During the recent Christmas season, 73 Christmas camp sessions were held across five countries, welcoming 5,000 campers. January to June is the main season for training camp leaders. Thirty training events are planned for 2026, with four already completed. The largest so far, held on February 7 in Ukraine, gathered 277 leaders from 101 camps.
