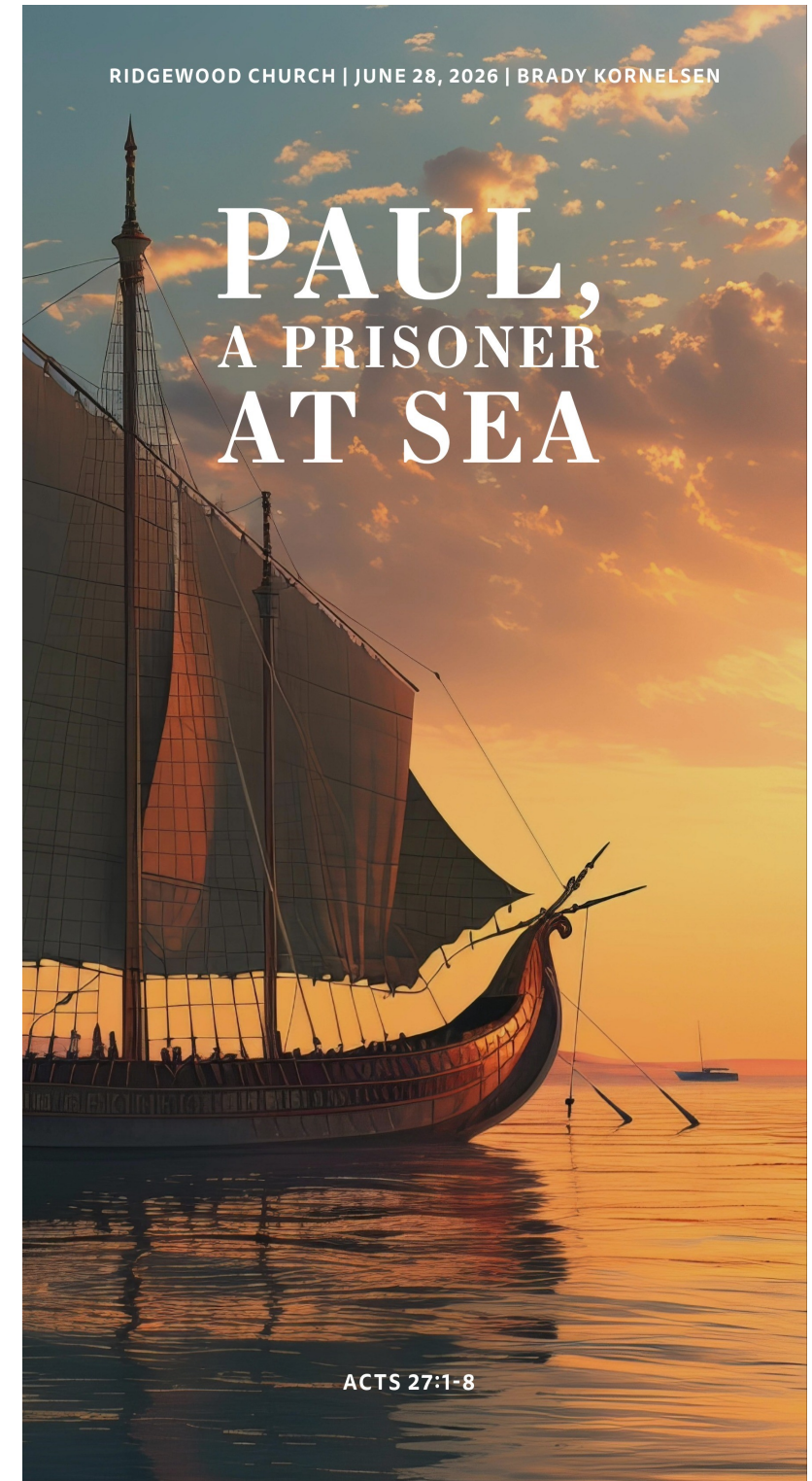

“King Herod’s brother must have died”

In the last weeks, Tiffany and the Achok team have been in Mark 6. We’ve noted a few different ways that our understanding has grown, or we have needed to make a tiny change to the words to avoid a big wrong meaning.

The story of John the Baptist being beheaded by King Herod had a bunch of these.

Resources for translators alerted me to a misunderstanding that frequently comes out in new translations. In Mark 6:17-18 Herod imprisons John for scolding him for taking his brother’s wife. In Achokian, “taking” is the common verb for getting married: “taking” someone as your wife/husband.

I asked a couple Why-questions - Why did John scold Herod? Why did Herod take his brother’s wife? It turns out the understanding was that Herod’s brother had died! The Achok had a lot of faith in Herod’s decency. Once we added a little word to say that Herod took his brother’s wife against him, all was clear. The translators then exclaimed, “No wonder John was scolding him!” His brother was still alive!

Thanks for being with us in this challenging and fascinating task!

Pray that we handle God’s word rightly.

Pray for the Achok translators and for our family to grow in closeness with God as we do what he sets before us each day.
