And he was still open because people kept coming! Every time we’re there, he comments on the incredible depth of teaching the teens are a part of... he is so encouraged.

As a leadership team, it’s being impressed more and more that ministry in the community IS happening... not through program, but by taking time for relationship. It just so happens that Oasis Teens is a vehicle the Lord is using!
